







?	Have / Has +  + got

Examples:

I *have got* three dogs - Ja *mam* trzy psy..

Tony *has got* a pen. - Tony *ma* długopis.

They *haven't got* a cat. - Oni *nie mają* kota.

She *hasn't got* a bike. - Ona *nie ma* roweru.

*Have you got* a parrot? - Czy Ty *masz* papugę?




*Has he got* a blue hat? - Czy on *ma* niebieski kapelusz?








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
